MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

NAVAL MEMBERS

Past and present members, including WRANS and RANNS of the Royal Australian Navy, regular or reserve forces, or navies of other nations serving, or who have served with the Royal Australian Navy, officers and men and women of any Commonwealth Navy and the Royal Marines.

SERVICE MEMBERS

Serving or past members of the Australian and Commonwealth Military Forces and Reserves and of the Royal Australian Air Force and Commonwealth Air Forces and serving or past members of the Merchant Marine of the British Commonwealth.

LOCAL MEMBERS

A person ineligible for Naval or Service Membership may be invited to submit an application form to be elected as a Local member if such person is of good standing in the community and is a boat-owner who is interested in the furtherance of the aims of RANSA.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

A person who is the spouse, son, daughter, widow or widower of a Naval, Service or Life member, but who is ineligible to be elected as a Naval or Service member.

SAILING ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

A person who is not eligible for any other sub-class of membership of RANSA and who is a regular member of a yacht crew or actively interested in the aims and activities of RANSA may be invited to become a Sailing Associate member.

JUNIOR MEMBERS

A person between the ages of twelve (12) and eighteen (18) years who is undertaking basic naval or military training.

COUNTRY MEMBERS

A person who is eligible to be elected as a Naval or Service Member who lives outside the metropolitan area of Sydney may request to become a Country member.

ELECTION PROCEDURES (Articles 40 – 49)

- (a) Nominations with completed questionnaires are tabled before Squadron Committee for consideration.
- (b) If approved, the names and addresses of the candidates, together with the names of Proposers and Seconders, are posted on the Notice Board of the Club.
- (c) When a candidate has been accepted for membership, the Secretary shall give written advice, and render an account for the first Annual Subscription and Joining Fee. Payment must be made promptly to commence membership.
- (d) At any stage prior to election, an application may be deferred or rejected. No reasons will be given for such decision. An application may be withdrawn by the Proposer, Seconder or applicant at any time.
